II. Procedure

A crucible and lid were heated with a Bunsen burner for about one minute in the hottest part of the burner flame. After the crucible and lid had cooled, the mass was recorded and 0.5 grams of silver oxide was added to the crucible. The mass of the crucible, lid, and silver oxide was recorded. The crucible was placed on the burner with the lid slightly ajar (Figure 2) and the flame heat was gradually increased over approximately 25 minutes. The final mass of the crucible, lid and silver metal product were recorded and qualitative observations of the product were recorded.
